2. Riding On A Donkey

- Matthew 21:9, NIV – (9) *The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Hosanna in the highest!"*

3. The Upper Room

- Matthew 26:26-28, NIV – (26) *While they were eating, Jesus took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body." (27) Then he took the cup, gave thanks and offered it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. (28) This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.*

4. The Kidron Valley

- Matthew 26:30, NIV – (30) *When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.*

5. The Trial & Crucifixion

- Matthew 26:65-66, NIV – (65) *Then the high priest tore his clothes and said, "He has spoken blasphemy! Why do we need any more witnesses? Look, now you have heard the blasphemy. (66) What do you think?" "He is worthy of death," they answered.*
- Matthew 27:22, NIV – (22) *"What shall I do, then, with Jesus who is called Christ?" Pilate asked. They all answered, "Crucify him!"*
- Matthew 27:30-31, NIV – (30) *They spit on him, and took the staff and struck him on the head again and again. (31) After they had mocked him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him.*
- John 19:30, NIV – (30) ... *[Then] Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*

CONSUMED

- “To be consumed” = “katesthio” (Greek) = “to be fully absorbed; to be devoured completely; to be eaten up, to be swallowed up”

JESUS WAS CONSUMED WITH US

1. Jesus In Heaven

- Romans 3:23, CEV – (23) *All of us have sinned and fallen short of God's glory.*
- Isaiah 59:2, MSG – (2) *There's nothing wrong with God; the wrong is in you. Your wrongheaded lives caused the split between you and God. Your sins got between you so that he doesn't hear.*

2. Jesus And John The Baptist

- John 1:29, NIV – (29) *The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"*

3. Jesus' Temptation In The Desert

- Matthew 4:3, NIV – (3) *The tempter came to him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread."*
- Matthew 4:5-6, NIV – (5) *Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. (6) "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "'He will command his angels concerning you, and*

they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

4. Jesus And The Afflicted

a) The Blind

- John 9:11, CEV – (11) *He replied, "The man they call Jesus made some mud and put it on my eyes. He told me to go to Siloam and wash. So I went and washed, and then I could see."*

b) The Demonized

- Mark 1:25-26, CEV – (25) *Jesus told the evil spirit, "Be quiet and come out of the man!" (26) The spirit shook him. Then it gave a loud shout and left.*

c) The Lame

- John 5:8-9, CEV – (8) *Jesus told him, "Pick up your mat and walk!" (9) Right then the man was healed. He picked up his mat and started walking around.*

5. Jesus And The Despised

a) Tax Collectors

- Luke 19:2,9-10, NIV – (2) *A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. ... (9) Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. (10) For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."*

b) Adulterers

- John 8:3,10-11, NIV – (3) *The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group. ... (10) Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" (11) "No one, sir," she said. "Then neither do I condemn you," Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."*

c) The Rich

- Matthew 19:16, NIV – (16) *Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, "Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?" ... (21) Jesus answered, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."*

d) The Promiscuous

- John 4:13-14, NIV – (13) *Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, (14) but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."*

6. Those Bound In Religion

- John 3:1-3, NIV – (1) *Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a member of the Jewish ruling council. (2) He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him." (3) In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."*

7. Those Who Have Failed Miserably

- John 13:37-38, NIV – (37) *Peter asked, "Lord, why can't I follow you now? I will lay down my life for you." (38) Then Jesus answered, "Will you really lay down your life for me? I tell you the truth, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times!"*
- John 21:16, NIV – (16) *Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you truly love me?" He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep."*

JESUS' MISSION

1. To Jerusalem

- Luke 9:51, NIV – (51) *As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem.*
