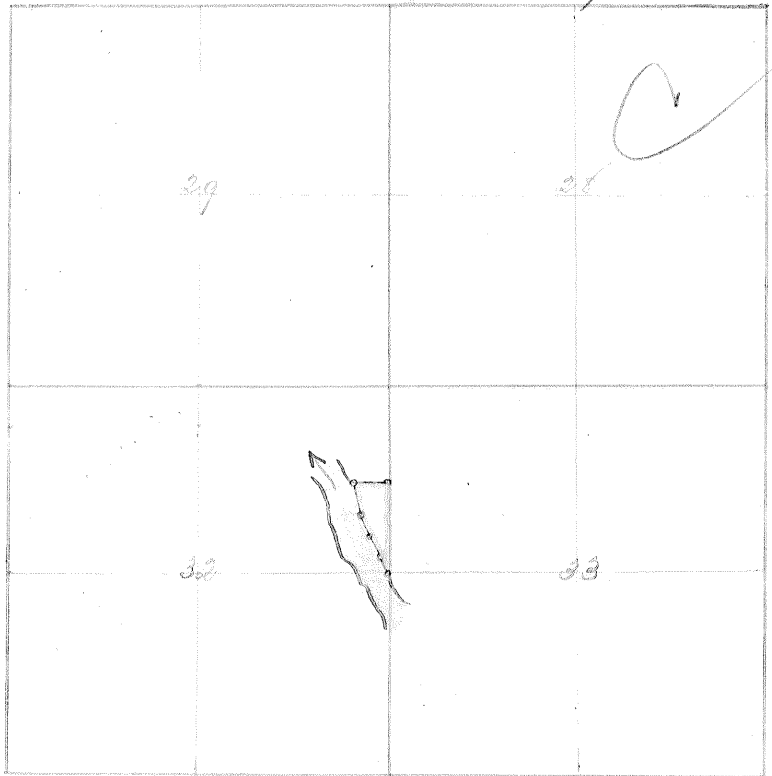

Beginning at a post on the right bank of San Joaquin River where the North & South lines between sections 32 & 33 T. 3. South Range 7 East intersect said river thence North with said section line 16 chains to a post set as the south east corner of Swamp and Overflowed land Survey No. 73 thence west and with the south line of said survey 5 chains to a post on the right bank of the San Joaquin River thence meander said river on its right bank up stream S. 9 1/2 E. 7.55 ch - S 33 1/2 E. 4.70 ch, S. 14 E. 4.80 ch to a post on right bank and point of beginning

Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation 15.45 East.
